Sunbreak is designed to be a large-scale temporary ranch in the layout of the Old California Ranchos – befitting California’s rich history and topography. It will be a creative, one-of-a-kind location featuring 35 plus amenities and benefits that strive to make the Ranch the best possible temporary home for our homeless brothers and sisters, friends and neighbors.

- We pledge a better, more comfortable, and safer night’s sleep than on any sidewalk, anywhere
- Safe + Secure + Clean
- Spectacular open space setting with fresh air and breathtaking views
- A respectful and friendly Sunbreak Ranch staff motivated to help lift you up, not tear you down
- A place where threats to personal safety and public health will not be allowed
- Permanent police post on site to maintain peace and safety
- Private security patrolling the Ranch 24 / 7 as an extra layer of safety and security
- Ranch easily accessible via highways 905 and 125, and only 13 miles (15 minute drive) from downtown San Diego; MTS bus / trolley service is already in place nearby; and there will be a Sunbreak Shuttle service with a set time schedule
- Residents can come and go from the Ranch as they please
- No residency fee – residents only have to respect others and clean up after themselves
- Free WiFi Internet access on the Ranch
- A sheltered bed available for everyone – with a choice of multiple communal living quarters, as well as tenting on your own on the outskirts of the Ranch if preferred
- Homeless Community Groups may be housed together if desired
- Separate shelter choices available for single women, single men, families, homeless children, those with pets, veterans, disabled, etc.

- Multiple portable bathroom and shower facilities on site
- Large mess hall tent serving three healthy meals a day at set times – also used for communal gatherings, inspirational talks, and entertainment
- Homeless Service Provider tents and social services on site
- First-aid tent on site with CPR and emergency trained staff
- Medical jitney service on standby 24 / 7 for emergency hospital runs
- Schooling for children on site and / or shuttle runs to public schools
- Personal grooming tents for haircuts and such
- Laundry services on site
- Storage on site for personal belongings
- Postal referral services and mail delivery on site
- Non-profit General Store on site carrying the most widely used items by the homeless at the best prices, no more overpriced convenience stores (will also be carrying donated items from the public)
- Job training tents and programs
- Job interview tents
- Gardening and farming opportunities – with an actual plot of land designated to work crops and livestock
- Daily AA 12-Step Meetings on site
- Religious services and counseling available on site
- Dependency referral services on site
- Mental Illness referral services on site
- Disability referral services on site
- Recreational areas for physical fitness and sports – horseshoes, basketball, volleyball, etc.

- Playground for children
- Dog run and training areas
- Smoking areas on site
- Inspirational / quiet areas on site
